What knowledge, skills and competencies will students have gained upon complementation of the program?	
<b>3 Target Groups</b>	
3.1 Target Groups	For whom is the program designed?
3.2 Program Prerequisites	What prior knowledge, skills and competencies should applicants have?
3.3 Target Numbers	How many students do you plan to enroll per semester?
<b>4 Analysis of Need</b>	
Where might graduates of this program work in the future?	
<b>5 Competition Analysis</b>	
5.1 External Competition Analysis	How does the program perform in national and international comparisons?
5.2 Internal Competition Analysis	Are there other TUM programs with similar focus? If so, how does this program differ?
<b>6 Structure of the Degree Program</b>	
How and when in the course of the degree program will students gain specific knowledge, skills and competencies? Why have these methods of instruction been selected?	
<b>7 Organization and Coordination</b>	
Who is responsible for program content and organizational matters?	
<b>8 Resources</b>	
8.1 Staffing Resources	What staffing resources are required to implement the program and achieve the intended outcomes of the qualification profile? Are they available?
8.2 Material Resources/Rooms	What material resources/rooms are required to implement the program and achieve the intended qualification profile? Are they available?
<b>9 Advancements</b>	
What major amendments to the degree program have been adopted? Why have these changes been necessary?

What supporting documentation is appended to the degree program documentation, e.g. letters of intent, reference material, letters of recommendation, etc.?
